

YEARS 3 / 4 DOJO HOMEWORK – SPRING HALF TERM 2

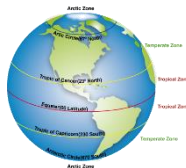
Homework activities for this term are outlined below.

Computing: Use purplemash to code your own seascape. Use 2code gibbon on purplemash. Can you make your animals move? Do they make a sound?
