






Dear Parents/Carers,

The Ethos Team have been very busy this week writing a new school prayer. A copy of the new version is on the front page of this Newsletter, and they are also around school helping children to learn it by heart. This prayer of thanks and reflection of our day is said in every Worship and at the end of the school day.

Attendance

Our current overall school attendance is just within our target of 96%, standing at 96.8%. This is great and we need to keep growing this figure, making sure that children are in school everyday and learning. 68% of pupils have 100% attendance so far this year. Hopefully this figure will stay high into the Autumn Term, and we have some special 100% attendance badges for those that manage to be in school for every day in Autumn.
