

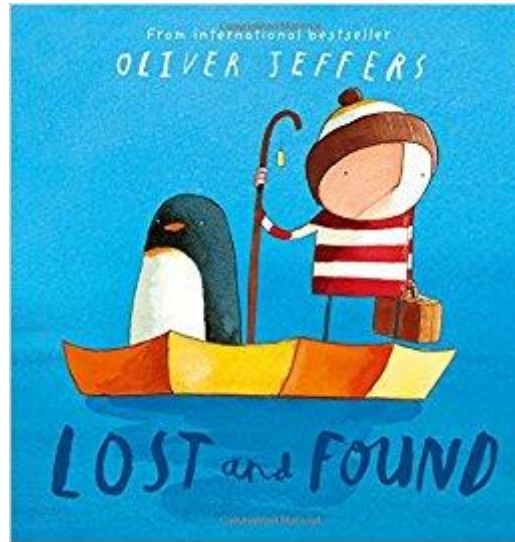
The Future is in Your Hands – Frozen Worlds

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

- I will be discussing how I can be a good friend.
- I will be learning about the importance of sharing.
- I will understand how we are all unique and we are all important.
- I will practise playing in our role-play areas with other children, understanding that we play in ways which respect each other, and listen to each other's ideas.
- I will participate in class P4C and share ideas and opinions.

Literacy

- I will be listening and reading stories about animals from the North and South Poles, or with themes of cold weather.
- I will be writing a Lost Poster.
- I will write a letter to a police man to tell them I have found a Penguin.
- I will be writing lists of items to take on an expedition.
- I will send a postcard to describe the journey to the Antarctic.
- I will write about an Inuit.
- I will learn new sounds, tricky words and high frequency words in Phonics.



Maths

- I will be using, ordering and writing numbers to 10/20 and beyond.
 - I will be estimating quantities.
- I will be counting actions and sounds.
- I will be sorting and describing 2D and 3D shapes and using them to make Arctic/ Antarctic pictures and models.
- I will be making symmetrical pictures of igloos, penguins and Inuits!

- I will be adding one, and two more.
- I will be continuing a repeated pattern.
- I will be finding different ways to make 10.

Communication and Language

- I will develop and extend my vocabulary through role-play, rhymes and stories related to the topic.
- I will be learning new songs and singing my favourite songs and rhymes
- I will be discuss ways to keep warm.
- I will talk about the lives of animals in winter.
- I will be hot seating different story characters from winter themed books.

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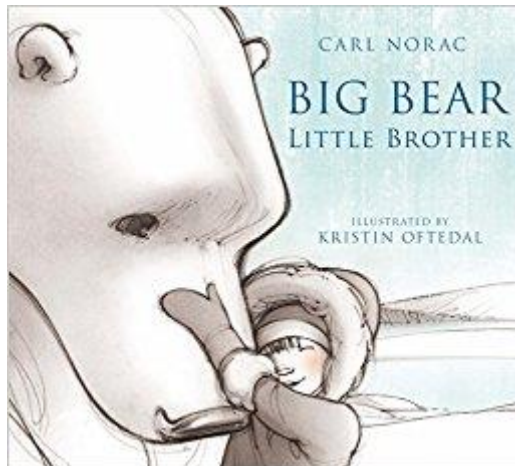


Expressive Arts and Design

- I will look at famous artists pictures of wintry scenes.
- I will do an observational drawing of a winter tree.
- I will make snowflakes.
- I will use charcoal to make a polar bear picture.
- I will collage a penguin.
- I will be learning winter songs.
- I will be exploring how different animals move.
- I will paint, draw, model using a variety of media, exploring colour, texture and shape (2D and 3D) to make wintry pictures.
- I will be making the sounds of a winter storm with different instruments.

Physical Development

- I will be finding out what I have to do to live a healthy life style including sleeping and keeping clean.
- I will be taking part in PE and joining in new activities.
- I will learn and observe the effect of exercise on my body.
- I will talk about road safety on dark nights.
- I will learn to move in a variety of ways in the hall and outside, pretending to creep like a polar bear, dance like a dragon for Chinese New Year.
- I will use tools, construction/malleable, threading materials, selecting and using them appropriately.



Understanding the World

- I will learn about creatures that live in the Arctic and Antarctic.
- I will be investigating the properties of ice and snow.
- I will use Small World play to explore different environments.
- I will use a variety of different construction sets to make, build, construct and adapt models of a range of different animal and human homes from different climates.
- I will be using 2simple software to design winter clothing, and to sort appropriate clothing.
- I will be looking at the Polar Region locations in pictures and on maps, in relation to the UK.
- I will be drawing my own map to plot a journey to the South Pole.
- I will use a laptop to write my own name.
- I will design, build, and test a boat for the boy and the penguin to sail in, reviewing and amending my design as necessary.

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
