Register

Collecting Children

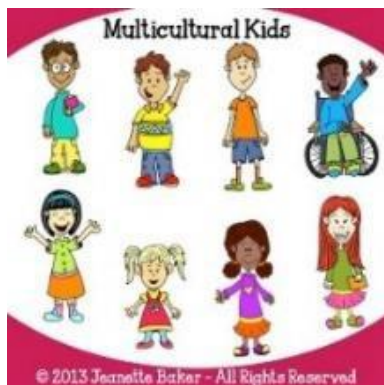
If your child is to be collected by someone other than yourself we ask that you contact us beforehand by email or telephone as above confirming the alternative arrangements.

Full fees are payable for sessions missed through sickness, holidays and cancellations.

All children who attend Oswald Owls are made aware of the school's behaviour policy regarding acceptable/unacceptable behaviour and encouraged to follow the school's 'Golden Rules' at all times.

The children actively take part in group discussions to draw up their 'Club Rules', 'Table Manners' & the 'Waiter/Waitress' charts encouraging independence & confidence.
